

Craft Instructions

Easter Box Chick

Supplies

- Coloured Card
- Glue Stick
- Two egg box segments
- Scissors
- Yellow paint
- Googly eyes
- Paint brush



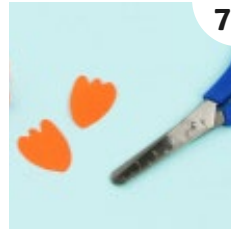
- 1** Trim the egg box segments so that there are no loose edges.



- 6** Cut out the triangle.



- 2** Stick a small strip of card to one side of the egg box, leaving an overhang.



- 7** Draw two small feet from the left over card and cut out.



- 3** Turn the second egg box segment upside down, then sit it on top of the first egg box segment, and attach them together using the strip of card.



- 8** Now glue all of the features onto the egg box chick; first glue the feet onto the base and the eyes onto the front. Then open the chick and glue the wings and beak on, then leave to dry.



- 4** Paint the outside of both segments yellow, then leave to dry.



- 9** Fill with tissue paper and small chocolate eggs or other treats.



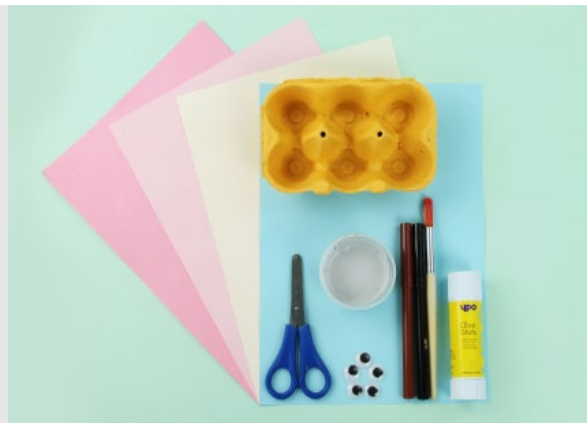
- 5** Now make the beak for the chick. To do this, fold a piece orange card, then draw a triangle, making sure that it is against the fold.

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Step 8. Now glue all of the features onto the egg box chick; first glue the feet onto the base and the eyes onto the front. Then open the chick and glue the wings and beak on, then leave to dry.



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
