

# Prefix

A prefix is a letter or group of letters that is added to the beginning of a word.

When you add a prefix you change the meaning of the word.

Example:

Kind: sympathetic, helpful, gentle    Unkind: inconsiderate, harsh, unhelpful

## The most common prefixes are:

1. **Pre:** means before
2. **Re:** means again
3. **De:** means undo or remove
4. **Dis:** means undo or remove
5. **Non:** means not
6. **Im:** means not
7. **Semi:** means half
8. **Mid:** means middle
