Then choose one planet that you find interesting and you'd like to find out more about. Include the name of the planet, a drawing and any interesting facts that you find.

Part of your project could be a diary entry – pretend you're an astronaut and write a recount of your time in Space. Talk about the things you took with you to Space, life inside of a spaceship, planets you saw (use your imagination!).

I have attached some of the pages from Small World on to the blog to help you with your project. You don't have to complete these pages - you can read through them to find some information. I've also attached fact files that might be useful. There are some websites below with information on the Solar System. Information can also be sourced from books that you may have at home.

Spend a little bit of time each day over the next **two weeks** exploring the Solar System - collect information, draw lovely pictures and most importantly have fun creating your project!
