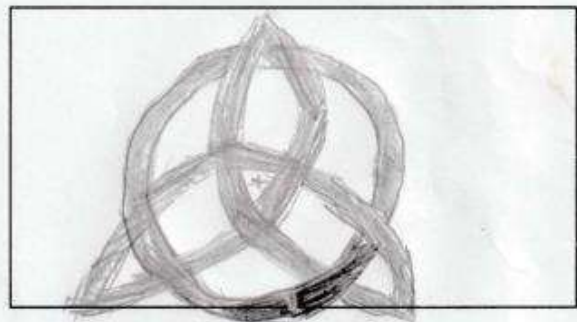
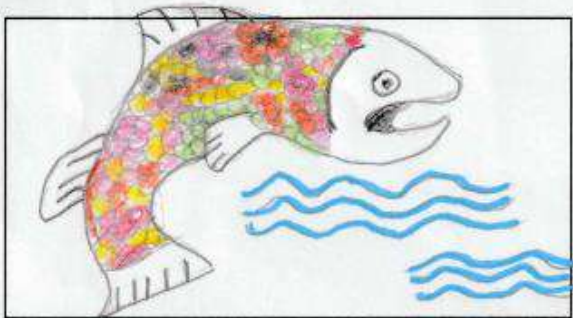


The Salmon of Knowledge

In 5th class they have been learning about long division.

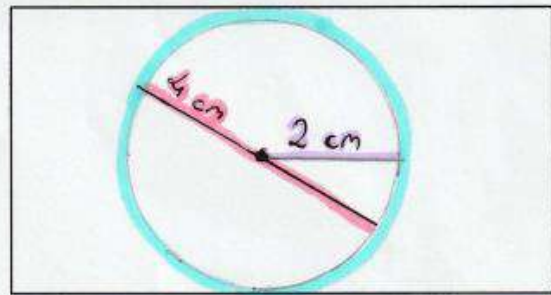
They are also trying to get a pen license.

Also they learn about Improper Fractions

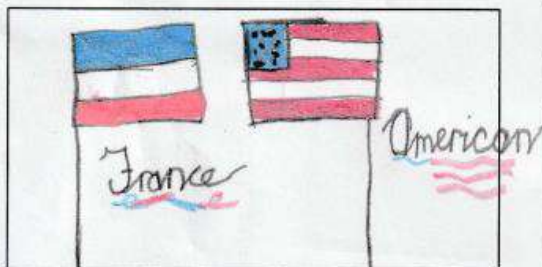

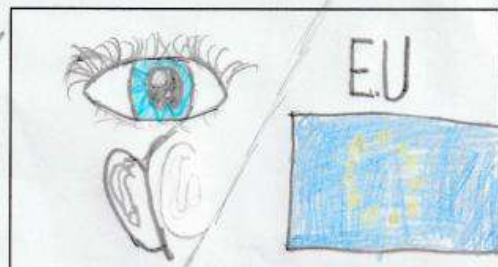
The 6th class are mixing up doing some subjects.
